PURPOSE AND LEGITIMATION OF THE TREATMENT:

The purpose of collection and processing of personal data provided on the website of Benidorm City Council will depend on the form of data collection used by the user: perform the processing requested by the user, meet a demand for processing or telematic service, keep it informed of news and developments related to Benidorm, etc.

The processing of personal data is legitimated based on the consent granted by the interested party or in compliance with a legal obligation.

However, each Web form will provide the user with their data protection information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations.

INFORMATION RECEIVERS:

As a general rule, the data will not be communicated to third parties unless there is express consent of the user or in compliance with a legal obligation applicable to the Responsible.

DEADLINE OF CONSERVATION:

The personal data will be kept for the periods provided in the applicable provisions.

RIGHTS OF STAKEHOLDERS:

The interested party may exercise their rights of access, rectification, deletion, opposition, limitation and portability in relation to their personal data by writing to the address of the Town Hall or by email to dpd@benidorm.org, providing a copy of the ID or equivalent identification document.

Users can also contact the Spanish Agency for Data Protection (AEPD) to submit a claim when they do not consider their request duly answered.
