

Cookies Policy

The purpose of this cookie policy is to inform clearly and precisely about the cookies that are used on the website of Benidorm City Council (hereinafter, the “**web**”).

What are cookies?

A «cookie» is a small data file that is downloaded to the terminal (computer / smartphone / Tablet) of visitors who access certain web pages (hereinafter, the "Users"), in order to store and retrieve information on the navigation that is done from them.

These files are stored in the User's terminal, and contain data that is not harmful for the computer. They are used to remember the preferences of the User, such as the selected language, access data or personalization of the page. Cookies can also be used to record anonymous information about how a visitor uses a website. For example, from which web page was accessed, or if you used an advertising banner to get there.

Types of cookies

Depending on what entity manages the domain from which cookies are sent and the data obtained is processed, two types can be distinguished: own cookies and third-party cookies.

There is also a second classification according to the period of time they remain stored in the User's browser, which may be session cookies or persistent cookies.

Finally, there is another classification with five types of cookies according to the purpose for which the data obtained is processed: technical cookies, personalization cookies, analysis cookies, advertising cookies and behavioral advertising cookies.

Types of cookies used by Benidorm City Council

Benidorm City Council uses two types of cookies:

- Own cookies: They are sent to the User's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the User is provided.
- Third-party cookies: These are those that are sent to the User's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies.

In the case that these cookies are installed from a computer or domain managed by the editor himself but the information collected through them is managed by a third party, they cannot be considered as

own cookies.
